

LAND ACQUISITION

Land acquisition is the process by which private land may be acquired for public purposes. Usually land is first reserved under a planning scheme. Rights to compensation are available following the reservation of land and upon acquisition.

This seminar will address the limits on financial loss compensation, the differences between compensation for planning blight and following acquisition, and how best to prepare claims by affected persons.

From the perspective of both those acquiring land or having land acquired, an informed approach can prevent delays and ensure appropriate compensation is paid.
