MENTOR

As a mentor, you'll have the opportunity to guide our students in your field or industry. Teach them what you've learnt on your journey and help them discover their own career path.

BETTY AMSDEN AO MONASH ALUMNI MENTORING PROGRAM

Champion a current Monash student in their mentoring and leadership training. You'll be required to attend official events, keep in regular contact and have a minimum of four face to face meetings during the program. **March – October.**

SIR JOHN MONASH MENTORING PROGRAM

Mentor a student recipient of the Monash Scholarship for Outstanding Achievement. You'll be supporting your mentee with career planning, professional networks and post-university life skills. **April – November.**

THE MONASH BUSINESS SCHOOL INDUSTRY MENTORING PROGRAM

Mentor third or fourth year undergraduate or postgraduate business students. This program involves communication at least every two months and connects students to professionals at different stages in their careers and in a range of career paths. **April – October.**

LEADERSHIP EXCELLENCE WITH JOHN BERTRAND AO

If you have demonstrated excellence in your field, work with our multidisciplinary team of exceptional students on a six-month program alongside a community partner to scope the project and develop viable and sustainable solutions to an organisation's problem.

LGBTIQ MENTORING PROGRAM

Provide personal insight into navigating sexuality or gender identity at work with Monash students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex and/or queer (LGBTIQ). This is a six-month program for LGBTIQ students preparing to enter the workforce. There's a minimum time commitment of one hour per month.

GLOBAL CHALLENGES MENTORING PROGRAM

Mentor science students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science Advanced – Global Challenges (Honours) who aspire to become entrepreneurial scientists. Your level of involvement can range from being a guest speaker to a longer-term commitment with the Faculty.
